Matters dealt with at the meeting included:

- Approval of a proposal for the opening of a Short Stay Unit (SSU) at the Mackay Base Hospital
 for a 4 month trial period. The SSU will accommodate patients who require "a work up" before
 going home. Patients are inpatients admitted for 24 hours to see if they can be released or
 need to go into a ward
- Approval of a revised Board Committee structure. The Board Committees are as follows:
 Executive Committee (assisting the Board with strategy development), Audit & Risk Committee (assisting the Board in fulfilling its role in regards to oversight of risk and internal controls), Safety and Quality Committee (assisting the Board in its oversight of employee and patient safety and the quality of services) and Finance Committee (assisting the Board in its oversight of financial performance and budget).
- Review of a report prepared by Dr Gareth Goodier for James Cook University on the proposed establishment of a Tropical Australian Academic Health Centre (TAAHC). The aim of the TAAHC is to improve research into tropical diseases and translate this research into actions. It is also about education and recruiting in long-term quality staff. If the proposal to establish the TAAHC was agreed to by all relevant parties, Mackay HHS and the 4 northern HHSs would participate in the TAAHC in partnership with James Cook University.
