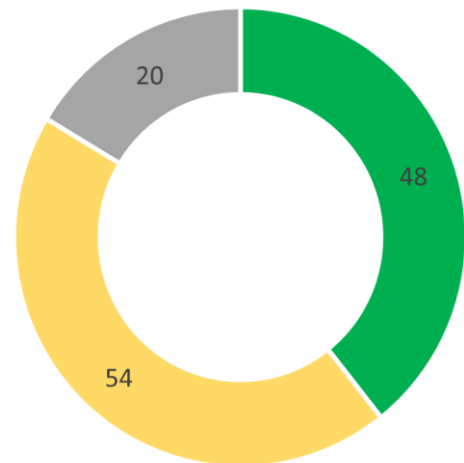

Latest Progress on Recommendations – Implementation Working Group

At the most recent meeting held on 6 February 2023, the group discussed policies, pregnancy and baby loss supports, open disclosure arrangements and training opportunities.

The group has now reviewed 102 recommendations and has determined that:

- 48 recommendations are completed
- 54 recommendations are underway but require further work or additional evidence

There are now 20 recommendations still to be reviewed.

Training – Partnering with Consumers

In March, Mackay HHS will be holding *Partnering with Consumers* training in conjunction with Health Consumers Queensland. Sessions will be available for doctors, midwives, nurses and executive. We are also holding sessions for consumers that have been appointed to any of our consumer advisory groups including the Maternity Community Reference Group and our Consumer Advisory Partners.

Survey of our staff on clinical handover and training enhancements

The O&G Implementation Working Group has considered a number of recommendations related to enhanced clinical handover processes and training. To understand how these enhancements are working on the ground, the group has distributed a survey to staff to get their feedback directly. The results of this feedback will be used by the Implementation Working Group to assess implementation success.

Expression of Interest open – sub-committee on physical environment

We are looking for interested people to join our sub-committee on the physical environment. There are a number of recommendations related to the Mackay Expansion Project which includes the P-Block and Birth Centre redevelopment projects. The sub-committee will report directly to the Implementation Working Group.
